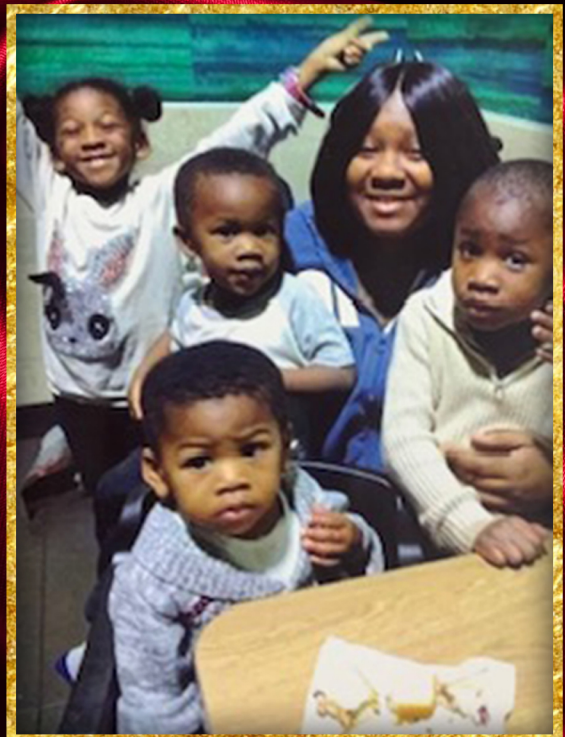
Shaneera Marie Bell was born on August 19, 1993 in Waukegan, IL.
