In my heart you'll always be

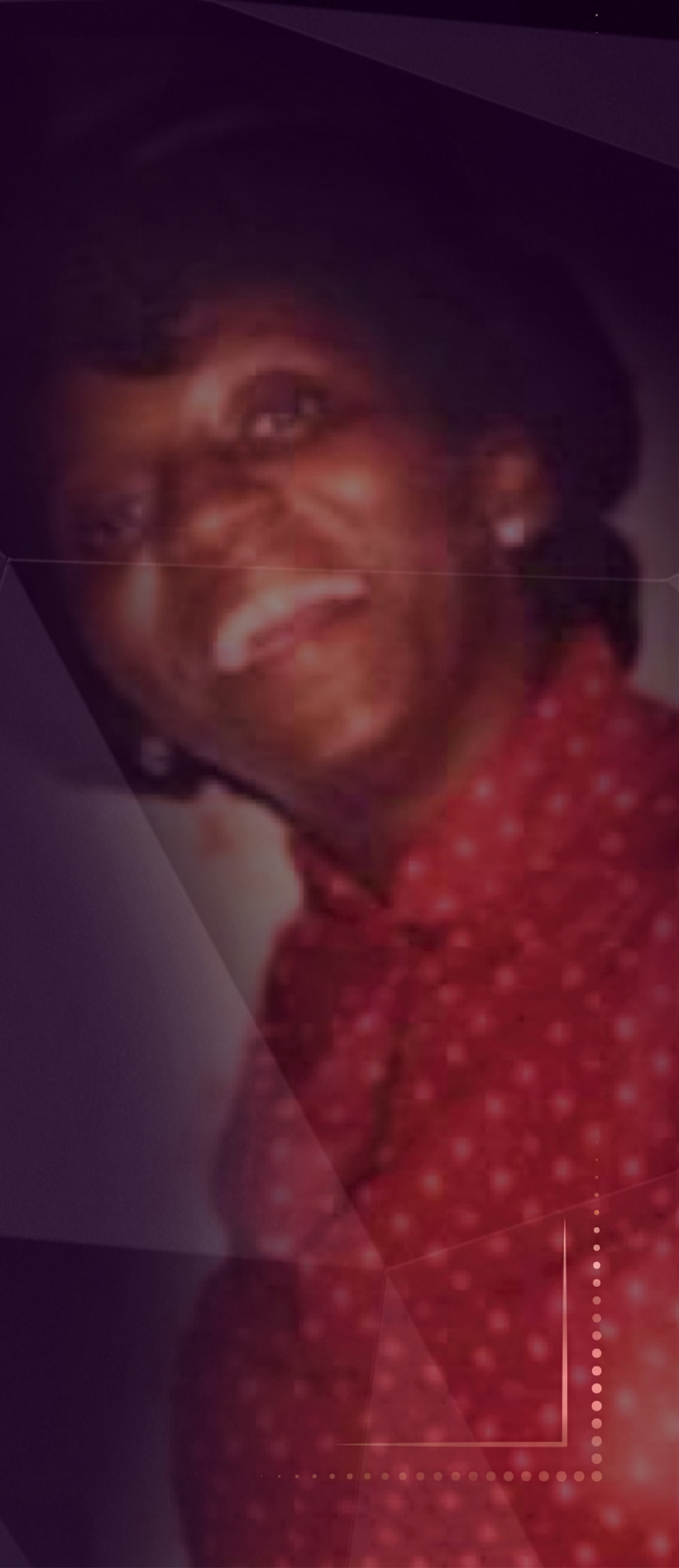
