Anthony attended elementary school in Los Angeles, California and then attended high school at South Shore High School in Chicago, IL.

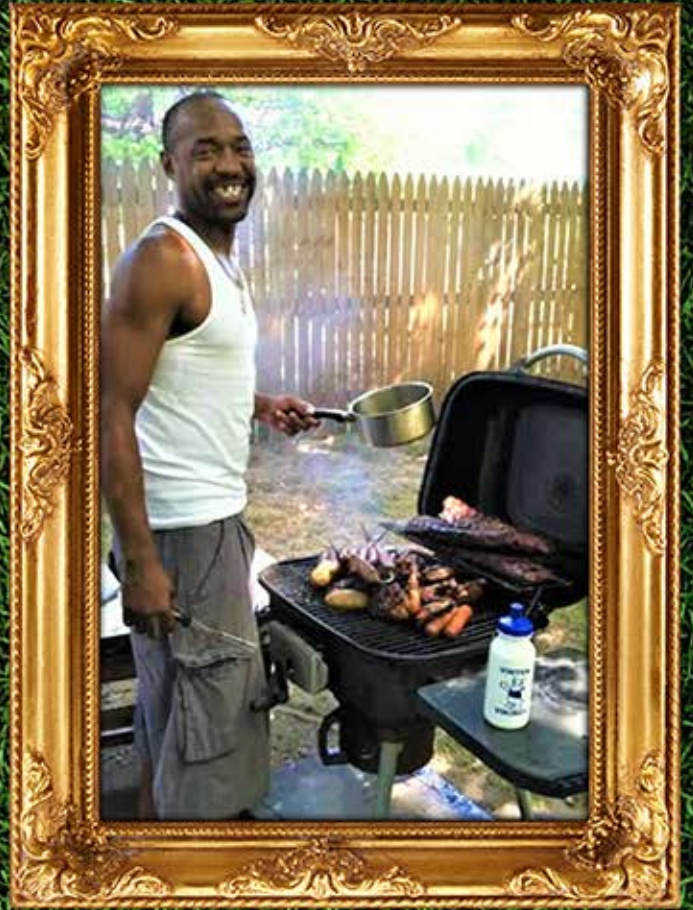
