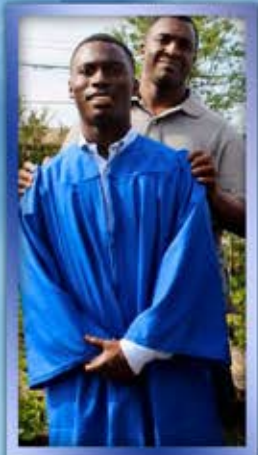
## *The Final Flight*
